

Preparation and arrangement of supporting documents, explanation/interpretation of rules and acceptance of these by the audit department is time consuming and complicated too. However, audit department has been asked to expedite the settlement of the issue.
  - 2. Settlement of cases in civil court require long time because of the long list of pending cases.
- 8. Steps taken to dispose the pending issues: Member (Finance & Trade) and Deputy Director (Finance) of Bangladesh Tea Board are meeting with audit authority regularly to expedite the settlement of audit objections.
  - 2. Lawyer has been engaged to plead and look after the cases pending with different courts of justice.
